The assessment comprises of three tests and includes 2 hours and 45 minutes testing time with 10 minutes of breaks.

Please be sure to arrive on time to school and plan appointments around this test date.

Fees are collected through bookkeeping. PSAT 9 - \$10. PSAT 10- \$15.
