Be sure to take your **admissions tests no later than December** — ***preferably earlier*** — to ensure that your application receives prompt and full consideration. If you already have the score you want, you report ACT and/or SAT scores on your admissions application, then request that an official copy of the scores be sent from the testing agency. You can have your official score report sent to one UC or CSU, and all campuses you apply to will receive it.

That way, you can get the information you need to create a list of schools you're interested in researching further. College fairs also allow you to discover specific things you want to know instead of just reading general information in brochures and online. And, if you have a strategy in place, going to a college fair can be a good way to see schools "close up." This can really focus your college search by helping you figure out what schools might be good to consider and which ones aren't a good fit for you. Although college visits are the best way to learn more about a school you're really interested in, a college fair can be the next best thing. It's a way to talk face-to-face with people from a school.
