CSU BOUND SENIORS - PLACEMENT TESTING

CSU requires you to take the English Placement Test (EPT) and the Entry-Level Mathematics Test (ELM) before you enroll. Your scores will determine which Math and English courses you should take to begin your career at CSU. **There are several test dates available but the very last date to take the combined test is May 6. In order to ensure a spot at a nearby CSU, please REGISTER NOW.**

To register for the EPT and the ELM exams, visit www.ets.org/csu. The fee for taking the EPT is \$20 per test.

Test Description: The EPT requires one hour and 45 minutes to administer. The test is broken down into one 45-minute essay section and two 30-minute multiple-choice sections that will test your reading and comprehension skills.

You May Be Exempt! You can verify that you are exempt by checking the criteria listed on the website.

Plan to take the test at whichever campus is most convenient for you. On the day of the test, you can select to have your scores reported to up to four CSU campuses.

UC BOUND SENIORS...

Analytical Writing Placement Exam -

All incoming students must take the UC AWPE on **Saturday, May 13**. In early April, students will receive a letter directing them to their test location.

ALL STUDENTS who will enter the University of California as freshmen must demonstrate their command of the English language by fulfilling the Entry Level Writing Requirement (formerly known as Subject A requirement).

Students can meet this requirement by scoring: 30 or better on the ACT, English Language Arts; or Combined English/ Writing, or 680 or better on the College Board SAT Reasoning Test, Writing (last admin. Jan 2016), 3 or above on either AP Exam in English. FOR MORE INFO:
